



**Third Annual Sexual Assault Yearly Speak Out  
Open Call for Performers**

The **Sexual Assault Yearly Speak Out (SAYSO!)** is a 24-hour vigil in which survivors' stories are read in a public act that breaks the silence around sexual violence. Organized by the **New York City Alliance Against Sexual Assault** and a community of volunteers, SAYSO! celebrates the strength of survivors.

This year's third annual SAYSO! is calling out to **PERFORMERS**. Every half hour a performance will introduce the powerful words of survivors, as well as their friends and families. We are looking for **ACTS OF CREATIVITY**, from live Music & Dance to Poetry & Spoken Word, from martial arts and yoga demonstrations to skits and anything else we haven't thought of yet...

Starting at noon April 21 until noon April 22, selected acts will perform in front of the main stage in Union Square Park. Each performance showcase must be appropriate for a 15-minute presentation on an outdoor stage. Basic sound equipment will be available.

**To submit, please mail complete contact information and a copy of a DVD or VHS copy of a recent performance with at least five minutes of highlights. The video will be the primary tool to evaluate submissions. Written proposals will also be considered. Supplementary CD recordings, photographs and letters of recommendation help. Materials will not be returned.**

**Submissions must be received in-hand by March 30; late entries will not be considered for selection.**
